

What is CARNet and when was it established?

- The Croatian Government established the Croatian Academic and Research Network – CARNet – in 1995 as an institution whose basic activities are network development, building and maintenance.

How are they organised?



- There are 96 employees in Croatia.
- CARNet's activities can be divided in three basic areas: Internet service provision, encouragement of information society development and education for the new era.

What is CARNet's mission?

- CARNet seeks to help its users in mastering and applying information technologies in their everyday life and work and in this way prepare them for information society.



Some of our missions are:

- Development of advanced information and communication infrastructure
- Improvement of higher education and science
- Stimulating information and communication technology implementation



- Providing support to knowledge dissemination and information exchange
- Co-operation with international organizations and linking with the academic and research networks, establishing and maintaining of central national services for the Internet.



How is CARNet connected?

- In Croatia, CARNet network connects major Croatian towns on land and a number of settlements on the islands.
- In everyday communication they use Polycom V700 for their video conferences.
- In every department they have large conference halls (TCR)

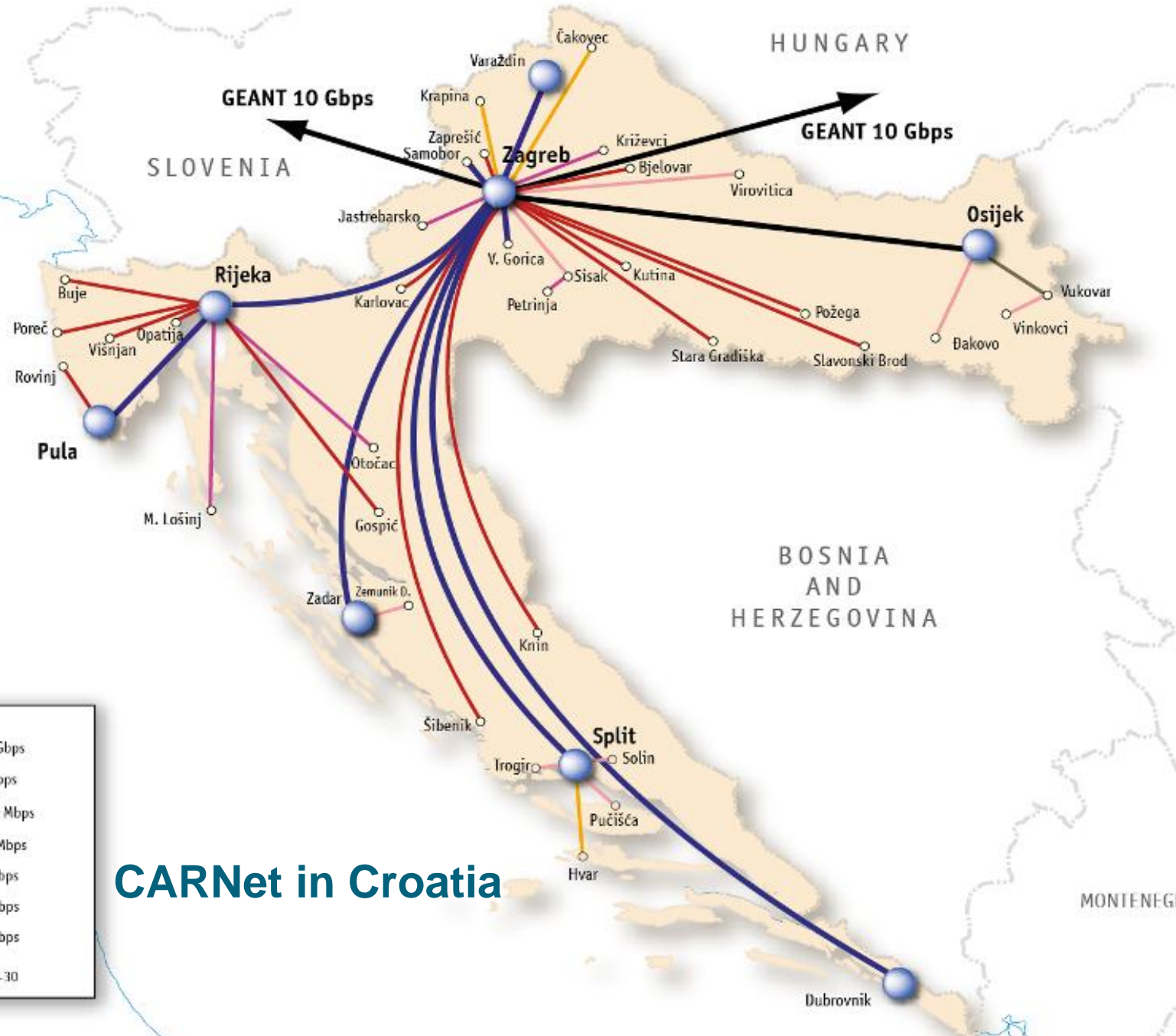


CARNet in Croatia
